### OFFICIAL COMMUNIQUE

1. Return to Dean's Office cards of all students who are absent 3 times. Do not readmit such students until they are approved for readmittance by the Dean's Office.
2. Students who accumulate 7 absences are automatically excluded from final examinations in courses and get a grade of F.

### HIGH SCHOOL VISITATIONS

Each of the Tennessee high schools will be visited by a faculty representative before the close of the present academic year. Schools in West Tennessee will be visited April 17-21; Middle Tennessee, April 24-28; East Tennessee, May 1-5.

### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Kindly file in the Dean's Office by April 15 all necessary information concerning any prizes or scholarships which faculty members or student organizations plan to offer at the 1944 commencement exercises. In this connection it is especially recommended that consideration be given to offering scholarships to ranking high school seniors who may desire to enter the college upon completion of high school courses.

### LABORATORY WORK IN EDUCATION

During the Spring Quarter students in the Division of Agriculture, Home Economics and Education are being assigned to do observation of and participation in teaching at Forde Greene Elementary School, Haynes High School, Washington Junior High School and the Nashville Christian Institute.

### EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF STATE LEGISLATURE

A bill providing for increase in school teachers salaries, to be offered in the forthcoming extraordinary session of the Tennessee legislature, will carry an appropriation of \$3,200,000.

### HARVARD PROGRAM FOR M. A. IN TEACHING

The following courses in education are the minimum requirement for candidates for the M. A. degree for teachers in the Harvard graduate school of Education: Educational Psychology, History of Education or Comparative Education or Social Teaching of Education, Secondary Education, Educational Measurement, Courses in Teaching accompanied by a practical apprenticeship and a course in the teaching of the major subject.
