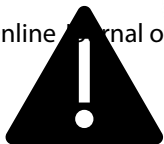

Names: Reform Alliance



Prevent re-incarceration of people under supervision who test positive for marijuana, associate with someone with a criminal history or travel outside jurisdiction.

Establish a system of incentives that reward good behavior.

Prevent Pennsylvania courts from sentencing someone to consecutive prison sentences or extending probation or parole over fines and fees for non-violent, technical probation violations
