A PROGRAM IN DENTAL RESEARCH...

FOR COLLEGE STUDENTS IN 1973 IS BEING SPONSORED BY THE AMERICAN DENTAL ASSOCIATION IN COOPERATION WITH THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF DENTAL RESEARCH AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, EDUCATION AND WELFARE. THE PROGRAM PROVIDES A STIPEND OF \$1,000 TO THE STUDENT FOR MAINTENANCE DURING A PERIOD OF 10 WEEKS IN THE SUMMER OF 1973 PLUS AIR TRAVEL EXPENSES TO AND FROM THE STUDENT'S ASSIGNED INSTITUTION.

A NUMBER OF FELLOWS...

FOR THE 1973-74 ACADEMIC YEAR, ARE BEING SOUGHT BY THE NEW YORK CITY MAYOR'S OFFICE FOR THE FIFTH YEAR OF THE CITY'S URBAN FELLOW-SHIP PROGRAM.

THE PROGRAM INCLUDES A WORK EXPERIENCE IN CITY GOVERNMENT IN WHICH THE FELLOWS ARE PROVIDED WITH SIGNIFICANT RESPONSIBILITIES IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROBLEM-SOLVING, RESEARCH POLICY PLANNING, AND RELATED MANAGEMENT AREAS, ETC. STIPENDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,000 EACH, WILL BE GRANTED BY THE CITY, PLUS ROUND-TRIP TRAVEL EXPENSES FROM THE FELLOW'S HOME. THE UNIVERSITY, IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE, IS RE-OUIRED BY THE PROGRAM TO GRANT ACADEMIC CRED-IT ACCORDING TO ITS OWN RULES AND REQUIREMENTS, PLUS A MINIMUM OF \$500 AND A WAIVER OF TUITION COSTS TO EACH SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT. SELECTION PROCESS IS BASED ON THE APPLICATION, PERSONAL STATEMENTS, RECOMMENDATIONS AND TRANSCRIPTS. ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY JANUARY 31, 1973. FURTHER INFORMATION AND APPLICA-TION FORMS ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE UNI-VERSITY PRESIDENT'S OFFICE.

THE URBAN FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM IS OPEN TO STUDENTS REGISTERED IN ANY UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM WHO WILL HAVE COMPLETED THEIR JUNIOR YEAR OF COLLEGE BY SEPTEMBER, 1973, AND TO GRADUATE STUDENTS. STUDENTS GRADUATING IN JUNE, 1973 OR EARLIER ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE UNLESS THEY HAVE BEEN ADMITTED TO GRADUATE SCHOOL.
