BY THE UNTIMELY DEATH OF FORMER STUDENT GEORGE SASSER, MAJOR, USAF, EXTENDS DEEPEST SYMPATHY TO THE MAJOR'S PARENTS, DR. AND MRS. EARL SASSER (MRS. ANNIE GRAY SASSER OF CAREER COUNSELING AND PLACEMENT). MAJOR SASSER WAS PILOT OF A FLIGHT OVER THAILAND THAT CRASHED WHILE RETURNING FROM A COMBAT MISSION ON DEC. 23. FUNERAL SERVICES WERE HELD AT NASHVILLE'S FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH, CAPITOL HILL ON JANUARY 2. MAJOR SASSER WAS A GRADUATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA.

CONTINENTAL CAN COMPANY AWARDS


