TO CHANGE FROM HIGH SCHOOL CERTIFICATE TO ELEMENTARY  
CERTIFICATE AFTER GRADUATION AND VICE VERSA

The holder of a permanent professional high school certificate may obtain the permanent professional elementary certificate upon completion of the following courses:

- 1. Methods;
  - a. Teaching the Social Studies in Grades ..... 3
  - b. Teaching the Language Arts ..... 3
- 2. Public School Music for Elementary Grades ..... 3
- 3. Art for Elementary Grades ..... 3
- 4. Health for Elementary Grades ..... 3
- 5. Student Teaching on the Elementary School Level ..... 3

Total (quarter hours) ..... 18

The holder may change from a permanent professional elementary certificate based on four-year curriculum to high school:

- 1. Meet the quarter hour requirements in high school subjects ..... 6
- 2. Materials and methods courses in two fields of Secondary Subjects in which the applicant will become certified ..... 6
- 3. Principles of Secondary Education ..... 3
- 4. Student teaching on the secondary level and in a certified area . 3

Total (quarter hours) ..... 18

WHAT IS THE AVERAGE SALARY OF A COLLEGE TEACHER?

The range (less than \$1,000 to more than \$9,000) among faculty members is so great that an average has little meaning. In 305 institutions studies in 1939-40 the median salary on a 9-month basis for teachers with the rank of professor was \$3,796, but 205 were paid \$7,000 or more, and 531 were paid less than \$2,000.
